Ian McLean

Ian McLean has exhibited at several public galleries, artist-run centres, and commercial galleries including Loop Gallery, Harbourfront Centre, Angell Gallery, Gallery Moos, Tatar Gallery, Gallery 1313, and Canadian Fine Arts in Toronto. Regional exhibits include the Glenhyrst Art Gallery of Brant (Brantford), Forest City Gallery (London), Transit Gallery (Hamilton), the St. Thomas-Elgin Art Centre (St. Thomas), the Thames Art Gallery (Chatham), the Woodstock Art Gallery, the Judith & Norman Alix Art Gallery, Handworks Gallery (Saint John, NB), and Sopa Fine Arts (Kelowna, BC). Ian's work was also included in the International Art Fair, "Love Art" in Toronto in 2014.

A former member of the Loop Gallery collective in Toronto, Ian has received two Ontario Arts Council Mid-Career Visual Artist grants. His work has been reviewed in various publications including *The Globe and Mail* and *Toronto Life Magazine* and was included in an auction of Contemporary Canadian Art at Waddington's in Toronto. He holds a degree in Studio Art from the University of Guelph and teaches Visual Art at Northern Collegiate in Sarnia. His work is held in private and corporate collections across Canada and internationally.

A 2013 Gallery in the Grove Scholarship recipient, Paula McLean received a Bachelor of Fine Art in Studio Art with a specialization in painting from Concordia University, Montreal in 2017.

Paula is a current MFA candidate at the University of Waterloo and has exhibited at several regional galleries including Propeller Gallery in Toronto; Mainline Gallery, Montreal; the Glenhyrst Art Gallery of Brant; and Forest City Gallery, London. In 2018, she was included in "Fresh Paint / New Constructions", an exhibit including top MFA students from across Canada at Art Mur Gallery in Montreal.

Paula is a teaching assistant and a sessional instructor in the Faculty of Fine Art at the University of Waterloo. A Shantz International Scholarship recipient, Paula assisted artist Ciaran Murphy in Ireland during the summer of 2018.
